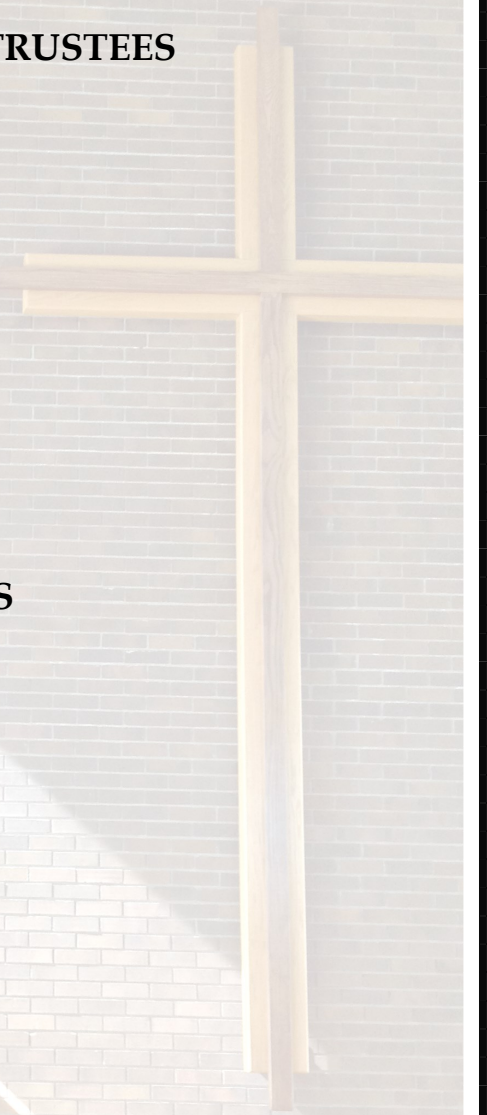

THE BOOK of LIVES is a project of re-membering, of telling something of the life of loved ones connected to UCiM who have passed on to their reward. Friends & visitors are welcome to browse through the stories of our beloved, which bear witness to the real lives and faith of our people.

Families who have lost a loved one may contribute one standard page (a photograph, short genealogy and biographical summary) that will be maintained in an attractive folio, to be kept on display in a public location in the church. Family members are asked to submit information and picture to the church office, where our staff will assemble the final page on heavier card stock for durability and appearance. (A sample of a page is illustrated opposite, with details for developing the page overleaf.) Submissions are invited on a continuous basis, year round. They will be ceremonially unveiled once a year on Unveiling Day.

UNVEILING DAY is a rite based on a Maori tradition in which the deceased are remembered one year after their burial. The Memorial Fund Trustees have chosen to introduce this tradition at UCiM, on November 1, 2015 – which will be All Saints Sunday. Photos of those remembered will be projected during worship, and the remembrance pages will be unveiled. Relatives of those who have died will be invited to attend and be recognized.

Our inaugural service plans to gather remembrances for those connected to UCiM without limit as to the date of death. We do invite anyone who would like to have a family member remembered at the 2015 service to contact the Church office or one of the Memorial Fund Trustees. After 2015, the Unveiling Day service will include loved ones who have had funerals/memorial services at UCiM during the previous two years. (eg 2015 & 2016).
